NEW BUSINESS

532 Old Front St. – The owner of the property is requesting to add an addition to the garage for storage. H. Vanhouten explained that a site plan is required for an addition which usually involves an architect who then generates a site plan. Sometimes small businesses will use graph paper and sketches out the existing structures and then put the proposed structure somewhere on that site plan which is acceptable as well. A site plan is required as it is needed in the records. The owner is building to the right of the existing structure. H. Vanhouten also requested that he talk to the Code Enforcer regarding getting a surveyor as the property lines are not clear. If the neighbor has survey pins, then a site visit with Kyle could be acceptable. We cannot approve a project without definite property lines being located. The site plan and having the property surveyed are the 2 concerns moving forward. The property owner may wait till next year to do the project as he did not realize all the steps it will take to get it approved.

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A motion by C. Klein and B. Sands to table this project till more information is provided. A site plan and potentially a survey is required. All in favor. Vote-5 Ayes, Nays-0, Absent-0.
